







Manuel works at ISSR, an Italian Public Institute which support deaf people. Manuel is an IT specialist and open source software fan.













Since one years ago, Manuel decided to migrate its Institute to LibreOffice and OpenSUSE










But the resistance to change of his colleagues is undereable...














A LibreItalia's member, Dora, who has been working with Manuel had an idea: asking the support of our association















On December 2015 Libreltalia met Manuel, Dora and Francesca to plane the possible agreement and Libreltalia's support and aid











On 29th January Libreltalia signed an efford with ISSR

Training for employees and deaf trainers of the Institute with a LIS professional interpreter












Delivering the LibreOffice Course Certificates to the partecipants







